2 DAYS / 2 NIGHTS – ALL INCLUSIVE

Enjoy a memorable experience that combines the exclusivity of a 1,000 hectare private estate with a five-star accommodation in the heart of Castilla-La Mancha, a land of beautiful landscapes that evoke the spirit of Don Quixote. A territory shaped by a long tradition of hunting while also committed to biodiversity conservation, and where Mediterranean woodland, dehesas, farmland and hills form the domains of the Iberian lynx. Explore the estate in a 4x4 along private paths, with the opportunity to move through a nature reserve where tranquillity prevails. Discover these landscapes of the eastern Sierra Morena, a privileged enclave of the Peninsula where emblematic birds such as the Spanish imperial eagle and the cinereous vulture can be observed in prime Iberian lynx territory—one of the most endangered felines on the planet. Accommodation on the estate itself in a five-star hotel, combines sophistication with nature. After each day of safaris, rest is complemented by exceptional gastronomy based on the tastes of La Mancha and local produce, along with the option to reserve a table at its Michelin-starred restaurant, enjoy its outstanding wine cellar, or relax in the spa. An intimate and exclusive experience where nature, privacy and refined hospitality come together to discover the wildlife of southern Spain.



A wildlife observation safari where the footsteps of Don Quixote of La Mancha merge with those of the Iberian lynx. Five-star accommodation and high-end gastronomy.

DAY 1 – WELCOME TO LA MANCHA

Arrival at Hotel La Caminera Club de Campo ***** (Torrenueva, Ciudad Real) and check-in to your selected room.
Introduction to your private guide and lunch at El Prado Lounge Restaurant, featuring the creations of Chef David Rey.
Afternoon 4x4 safari until sunset to explore the estate's paths and enjoy a first encounter with its wildlife.
Return to the hotel for time to relax and dinner at the restaurant.

DAY 2 – AMONG PARTRIDGES AND IBERIAN LYNX

After breakfast, the morning safari begins as we explore key areas to observe the Iberian lynx and other wildlife species. At midday, lunch will be served at the hotel restaurant (with the option of a countryside lunch). After a short rest, the afternoon safari continues the search of the Iberian lynx and birdlife, with stops at strategic observation points. The route lasts until sunset when we return to the hotel to relax before an exquisite dinner at the restaurant or an exceptional wine tasting with Manchego tapas in the estate's wine cellar.

DAY 3 – MORNING SAFARI AND FAREWELL

Breakfast at the hotel. Morning safari on the estate. End of the program before lunch and farewell.

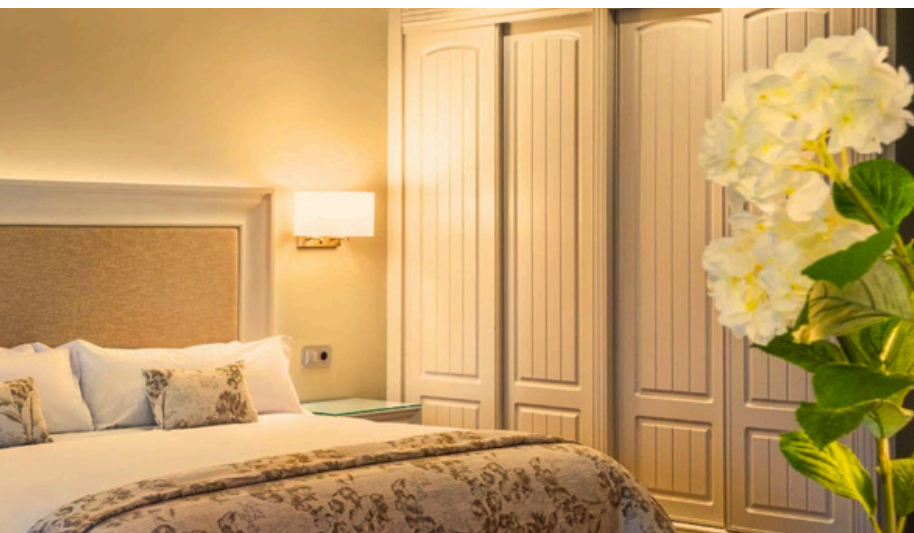

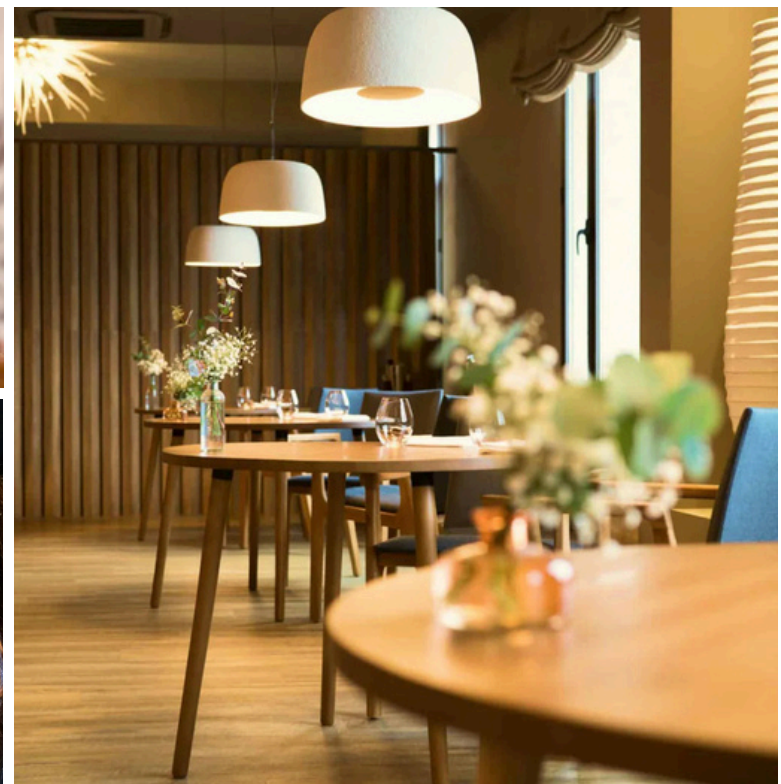
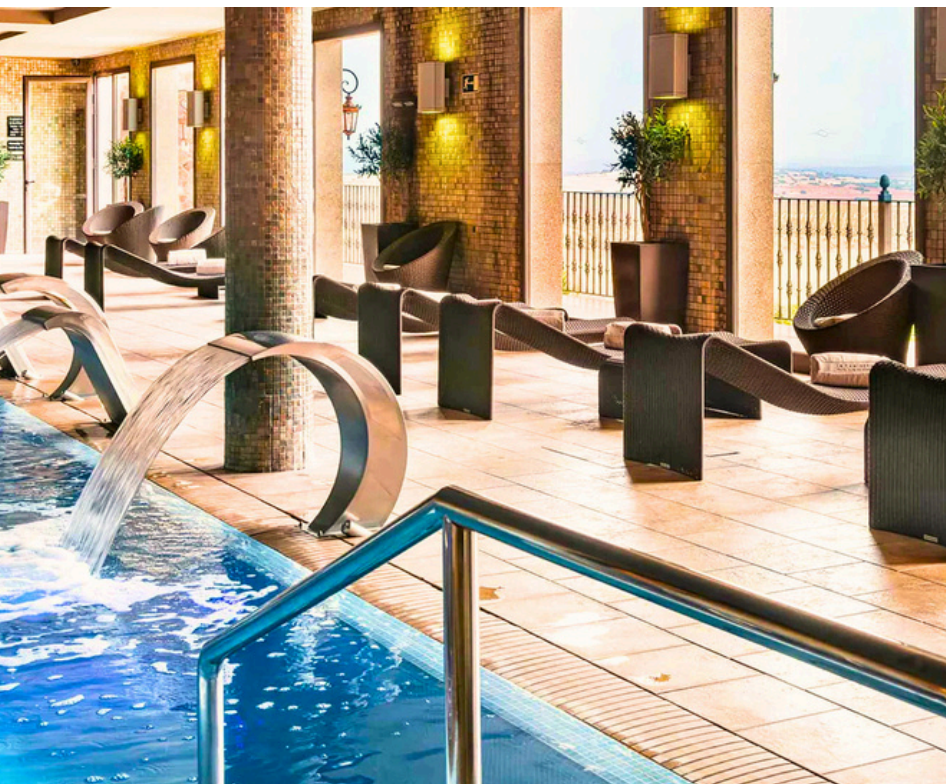
ACCOMMODATION-Hotel La Caminera Club de Campo *****

(December and January) with
increased daytime activity.

GENERAL RECOMMENDATIONS

- For safaris, please wear comfortable clothing and footwear suitable for the season. From May to early October, it can be hot, but you should always bring some warmer layers for early mornings and evenings. In autumn, winter and early spring, it can be cold and rainy, so please take this into account when planning your trip.
- If you choose to dine at Restaurante Retama (1 Michelin Star), the dress code is smart casual.
- Prepare for the sun (especially from April to October) with a hat, sunscreen, and sunglasses if desired.
- Don't forget your camera with fully charged batteries and memory cards.
- If you don't have binoculars, we can provide them for you.
- Bring a plug adapter if needed.
- Vaccinations: none are required for Spain, but it's always advisable to check with an international vaccination center for any updates.
- If you have any allergies or dietary restrictions, please let us know.
- Medications: travelers with chronic conditions should bring all necessary medication for the entire trip.
- Medical insurance: we strongly recommend traveling with international health insurance.
